PROGRAMME CONTENT

1. Instrument - harpsichord	 Improvement of harpsichord technique, sound sensitivity, conscious and independent solving of performance problems, also in the context of the student's future pedagogical work. Mastering harpsichord performance techniques in relation to the implementation of works in a variety of styles and depending on the type of instrument available. Improving the ability to work independently on the work - developing a musical text in terms of technical and artistic-interpretative issues, also in relation to formally construct the work. Preparation for public performances through the implementation of mandatory stage practices - broadcasts and concerts. Mastering, as far as possible, the harpsichord repertoire - from the 16th to the 18th century - in accordance with the student's interests and preferences.
