Aim of the studies:

- broadening the executive competencies;
- improvement of playing technique, ability of elaboration of musical text independently in technical and interpretative way for the public artistic presentation;
- developing knowledge of source literature, its styles and musical forms as well as executive matters related to the stylistic requirements of the epoch, school and compositional centre;
- perfecting the ability of conscious, independent interpretation of pieces of work considering their stylistics and musical content, allowing the public presentation;
- development of an autonomous artistic attitude during public presentation;

Candidates:

- persons holding a diploma of completion of at least first-cycle (undergraduate) music studies;
- graduates of foreign universities with a bachelor's or master's degree
 - a legalized or apostille-bearing diploma or another document of graduation of a higher education institution abroad is required, entitling to undertake postgraduate studies in the country in which it was issued, recognized in accordance with the provisions on the nostrification of diplomas of graduation of higher education institutions obtained abroad or on the basis of an international agreement, as internal to the relevant Polish diploma of graduation of first or second-degree studies;
- polish citizenship is not required;

Educational offer:

Date: October 2026 – June 2027 (two-semester studies)

- the language of studies is English or Polish (at the student's request).

- postgraduate studies are paid. The fee for Postgraduate Studies is determined annually by the Rector of the University.

In order to obtain a diploma of completion of Postgraduate Instrumental Studies, it is necessary to pass all subjects in the study programme. Methods and conditions of crediting are included in the course cards.

Recruitment

- Registration in the IRK system is mandatory and will be available via irk.chopin.edu.pl from June 1, 2026.
The amount of the fee for the procedure related to admission to postgraduate studies in the academic year 2026/2027 is 250 PLN. Your account number will be automatically generated after logging into the IRK system.
- Documents necessary for the recruitment process should be sent to the following address: podyplomowe.filia@chopin.edu.pl

Entrance exam:

The entrance exam takes place remotely. Instrumental skills are examined on the basis of the submitted recital recordings composed of the programme selected according to preferences and interests of candidate or candidates (applies to string quartet) – approx. 20-25 min. Each work may be submitted separately. Required sending of links to audio-video recordings on YouTube or Bilibili to the following address: podyplomowe.filia@chopin.edu.pl

Admission conditions – recruitment documents for foreigners:

1. application for admission to postgraduate studies (according to the template),
2. personal questionnaire (according to the template),
3. 2 photographs (size 3 x 4 cm),
4. a copy of the diploma of completion of first-cycle or second-cycle studies, or uniform master's studies – original for inspection,
5. obligation to bear the costs of postgraduate studies (included in the application form for admission to postgraduate studies),
6. a copy of the insurance policy against illness or accidents for the period of education in Poland or a copy of the European Health Insurance Card or a signed certificate of joining the insurance in the National Health Fund immediately after the commencement of education,
7. a copy of a legalized or apostille-bearing diploma or other document of graduation of a university abroad, entitling to undertake postgraduate studies in the country in which it was issued, recognized in accordance with the provisions on the nostrification of graduation diplomas of higher education institutions obtained abroad or on the basis of an international agreement for internships with the relevant Polish diploma of graduation of first or second degree studies or uniform master's studies.

Documents in a foreign language are submitted together with a sworn translation.

The compliance with the original documents submitted by the candidate is confirmed by the employee of the UMFC accepting the documentation.

Admission conditions – recruitment documents for candidates from Poland:

1. application for admission to postgraduate studies (according to the template),
2. personal questionnaire (according to the template),
3. 2 photographs (size 3 x 4 cm),
4. a copy of the diploma of completion of first-cycle or second-cycle studies, or uniform master's studies – original for inspection,
5. obligation to bear the costs of postgraduate studies (included in the application form for admission to postgraduate studies).

- In addition, a CV containing a brief description of musical education and artistic experience should be submitted.
- Should you choose the postgraduate studies in the field of string quartet, only registrations of the groups that establish string quartet will be accepted.

3 100 EUR – fee for one semestr with a minimum of two participants

3 250 EUR – fee for one semestr with one participant

2. Postgraduate Instrumental Studies in playing the violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, clarinet, horn, saxophone *(two - semester studies)*

3 650 EUR – fee for one semestr with a minimum of two participants

3 750 EUR – fee for one semestr with one participant

3. Postgraduate Instrumental Studies in playing the accordion *(two - semester studies)*

3 200 EUR – fee for one semestr with a minimum of two participants

3 350 EUR – fee for one semestr with one participant

4. Postgraduate Instrumental Studies in playing in a string quartet *(two - semester studies)*

810 EUR – fee for one semestr with four participants; minimum number of participants required to start studies: 3;
